#### 7. Additional information

The outcome of our previous project was young people wanted to know if it would be able to continue. After being made aware of rising issues on Trowbridge Railway we thought it would be a great idea to bring the two areas together to combine one project that will also have an educational element to it.

Tickets will be offered to young people in the 13 - 19 year age bracket. They must live in the Trowbridge community area; it is not only accessible to youth from Trowbridge 'central'.

Due to the price of tickets being different - under 15 off peak £3.70 over 15 off peak £7.40 it is difficult to say exactly how many young people can access the scheme. Using the over 15 option the amount of young people who would be able to buy tickets will be 405. If under 15's it will be 810.

We are proposing that tickets can only be bought one ticket per young person at a time and a maximum of 3 tickets per young person over the duration of the scheme.
