The Friends of the Strips was formed by local residents early in 2012 to restore and conserve The Strips after years of underfunding by The Strips' owners, Wiltshire Council and the District and Urban Councils before them. The proposed project will kick start restoration and raise the profile of our work by planting: - 30 Scots Pine trees to replace trees lost from the long row of mature pines that lines the main path through the woods. - A special memorial oak tree in the heart of the woods.

The existing but thinning canopy of trees is a key part of Bradford's south eastern skyline which dominates the view from Tory, Middle Rank and the town bridge. Without this planting that green skyline is at risk long term.

The Strips is a narrow wood that stretches along the south bank of the river from the golf club into the heart of the town forming a major part of the dominant green backdrop to the townscape. It is a very popular route to the town centre and St Laurence School, and is also used extensively by walkers and young people.

A long term Woodland Management Plan is being prepared with Wiltshire Council. We have circa 50 local volunteers and have already spent approximately 800 'man-hours' on working parties, completing a detailed survey of the woods, researching the wood's history and on public events to raise local awareness of The Strips.
