They were able to quote the experiences of themselves, their siblings and friends. These experiences included fears about inappropriate use of mobile phones, social media, and posting of photographs online. This was an issue for all age groups to varying degrees and primary aged children stated that they would like strategies to help prevent potential harm as they transfer to secondary school. Headteachers have also identified a need for greater awareness-raising for parents in monitoring internet and mobile phone use.

Exploratory talks with students and staff indicate the potential for meaningful outcomes for both pupils and students, giving an additional experience to what is on offer through the curriculum. The resource wi be used in schools and shared with parents in assemblies to broaden its reach. This project builds upon the succes of the 'Drive Safe, Walk Safe' project, funding by Chippenham Area Board, which culiminated in a DVD on road safety. Whilst a Chippenham initiative, once online it will be accessible to a much wider audience. The tangible output will be an online resource that delivers critical information to children and young people about their personal safety, with the intended outcome that Chippenham children are more aware of online risk and become more responsible and resilient users of information technology.
