SCHOOL TERMS AND HOLIDAYS 2014/15

Purpose

1. The purpose of this item is:
 - i) to report the findings of the consultation regarding proposed school term and holiday dates for 2014/15.
 - ii) to confirm County Secretaries' support for the recommended school term and holiday dates for Wiltshire's Community, Voluntary Controlled and Community Special Schools for the school year 2014/15.

School Term & Holiday Dates – 2014/15

2. In line with the recommendation of the JCC at its meeting in December 2012 a variety of interested parties including schools, neighbouring authorities, diocese plus others have been consulted on proposed term dates for 2014/15 (Appendix 1).
3. Appendix 2 details comments received as a result of this consultation.
4. A number of our neighbouring authorities have now either completed or are in the process of consulting on their own school term dates for 2014/15. The majority of our neighbours to the south west have consulted on dates similar, if not identical, to Wiltshire's proposal.

Proposal

5. The County Secretaries are invited to consider the responses to the consultation on the proposed school term & holiday dates for 2014/15 and decide whether to confirm its support for the dates detailed in Option 3.

Pippa Fisk	My main comment is that to have only 1 week off in October between terms 2 and 3 leaves an 8 week term 1 followed by a 7 week term 2. Having three children of school age, eight weeks without a break is a very long time to keep them focused and motivated. One week isn't enough to recharge their batteries before the next seven week term begins.
Miles Dennis	Having reviewed the options, I think Options 1 and 2 are equally preferable to Option 3 as they gives more holiday time when the weather should be better and there is more daylight.
Wardour Primary	We follow Dorset County Council dates.
Southbroom Infants	Preferred option is to match other schools in the area making it easier for parents with children at more than one school.
