Q7. If you have answered 'no' or 'partly' to question 6, what specific journeys would you not be able to make?

No return journey from Amesbury to Shrewton after 1400, so unable to shop / collect pension / go to gym in afternoon (2 respondents)

No return journey from Amesbury to Countess Rd after 1400, so unable to visit day centres or activities, or afternoon medical appointments (Willow Court and 2 other respondents)

Stay in Amesbury from Shrewton is too long (1 respondent, wants stay of just over 1 hour to attend gym)

Countess Rd service too inflexible - not enough journeys to allow convenient travel, including to medical appointments (Willow Court and 2 other respondents)

0925 journey from Countess Road is too early to be used by Willow Court residents due to their disabilities

Stay in Amesbury from Countess Road is too short to allow completion of shopping and appointments - needs 2 - 2 1/2 hours (1 respondent)

Morning stay in Salisbury from Woodford Valley is too long, and proposed 1320 return is in middle of lunch period (2 respondents)

No convenient early afternoon arrival in Salisbury from Woodford valley - proposed 1240 is too early (1 respondent, would find it difficult to attend afternoon clinic)

Morning stay in Amesbury from Upper Woodford is too short for combined shopping / lunch visit (1 respondent)

No afternoon return from Amesbury to Woodford valley (1 respondent)
