

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90A

1. TRAFFIC CALMING FEATURE – PEARCE WAY, LAVERSTOCK & FORD
2. PEARCE WAY, LAVERSTOCK & FORD – PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wiltshire Council in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 and the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes the following in Pearce Way, Laverstock and Ford:

1. The installation of Traffic Calming Tables at the following points:
 - a) 130 metres east of its junction with Hartley Way;
 - b) 60 metres west of its junction with Hartley Way.
 2. The installation of a raised Zebra Crossing at a point adjacent property No. 5 Saintes Close.
- The Tables will be of full carriageway width, a maximum height of 50mm, a maximum ramp gradient of 1 in 20 and will form a method of controlling the speed of vehicles in the interest of road safety.

A copy of the plan showing the location of the traffic table feature can be inspected at the offices of Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge during normal office hours. Details of the proposed scheme may be seen at Salisbury Library, Market Place, Slaisbury between the hours of 10am to 7pm Monday, 9am to 7pm Tuesday and Friday and 9am to 5pm Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday until 11th November 2013.
