NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wiltshire Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes the installation of a "PUFFIN" (Pedestrian User-Friendly Intelligent) Crossing, a form of traffic signal-controlled crossing in Wynsome Street at a point approximately 23 metres west of its junction with Church Street, as shown on the plan below.
