

Review of bus services in North West Wiltshire

Service 31 (Malmesbury - Swindon) - info sheet

Summary of proposed change

The current hourly service frequency is maintained between Malmesbury and Swindon. However, buses will run via Cowbridge (main road) instead of Milbourne and Lea (alternative services to Milbourne will be provided by extending some journeys of the Malmesbury town service; alternative services to Lea will be provided by diverting the Malmesbury – Cirencester service 93)

Commentary on current service

Service 31 provides an important strategic link between Malmesbury and Swindon, and is also the main public transport service for the villages along the route including Brinkworth and Little Somerford. It also serves the New Road and Noremarsh Road areas of Royal Wootton Bassett that have no other bus service. It currently provides a regular hourly service between approx 0700 and 1900 on Mondays to Saturdays.

It is generally well used, carrying around 94,000 passenger journeys a year. The diversion via Milbourne and Lea is however relatively poorly used, generating only around 22 single passenger trips a day. The service also experiences timekeeping problems due to the length of the route and these impact on other bus services with which it connects in Malmesbury.

Explanation of proposed changes

A regular hourly service will be maintained between Malmesbury and Swindon in view of its importance as a strategic link, operating at broadly similar times. However, the diversion via Milbourne and Lea village will be withdrawn in view of the relatively poor use, and because this will allow an improvement to timekeeping while still allowing the service to be run by a single vehicle. It is hoped that the reduction in journey time will also make the service more attractive for long distance passengers. It will also provide a new link from Cowbridge (main road stop) to Royal Wootton Bassett and Swindon, in response to requests received. These improvements are intended to make the service as a whole more sustainable and affordable. It is proposed that Milbourne will be provided with a service into Malmesbury by extending some journeys on the town service, operating around 7 times a day. Lea village will be served by diverting the Malmesbury – Cirencester service (93), providing around 5 journeys a day into Malmesbury and the opportunity to travel to Cirencester.

Proposed timetable

The proposed timetable for service 31 is shown overleaf. A summary is also given of the replacement services proposed for Milbourne and Lea.

The aim of the review of services is to make the bus network more sustainable in the long term, and to provide cost-effective services that meet the needs of existing users at an affordable cost to the council. We believe that the proposed changes meet these objectives, but if you have other suggestions about how this might be achieved we would be pleased to receive them.

Similar information sheets are available for each of the bus services affected by the North West Wiltshire review. A consultation on the proposals is under way and will close on 7 October 2013.
