Highways Update

The main highways work undertaken since 1 April in the Malmesbury community have been:

- A429 4km of resurfacing north of Filands
- A429 Malmesbury Bypass Roundabout repairs and retexturing on approaches to roundabout.

Holloway, Malmesbury is programmed for March.

Smaller sites currently being programmed include the B4040 at Easton Grey and west of Malmesbury to address skid resistance issues, and repairs at Crab Mill Lane, Alderton and Pinkney.

Proposed schemes for 2015-16 and a more detailed list of the works carried out in the Community Area will be presented in January.

In addition since April 666 defects (548 were reported using the App) have been addressed by the local highways team.

These have included:

- 253 minor carriage way repairs
- 99 issues relating to signs
- 72 incidences of fly tipping
- 66 maintenance of grass/verges
- 52 drain clearing

Plus many other activities such as litter bins, dog fouling, street furniture, maintenance of hedges and trees.

Other work by the team included working with BT to address a drainage issue on Holloway Hill, Malmesbury and supporting litter picking days in parishes with loan of equipment and collection and disposal of rubbish.
