<b>Please tell us about the project /activity you want to organise/deliver and why?</b>  <i>Important: This section is limited to 900 characters only (inclusive of spaces).</i>	<i>This small green area is in the centre of the housing area in Bowerhill East. It is not intended for formal sports activities. Over the past two years there have been noise and inconvenience issues as a result of youngsters playing football against the wall of a small electricity sub station on the edge of the area with houses alongside. The problem abated for a time following the installation of a MUGGA in recreation area not far away. The local police team have been involved and the Wiltshire Councils Play and Leisure Strategy Officer has following a site meeting recommended that the most satisfactory way to deal with this would be to make a planting feature of the whole strip of land from the substation up the side of the adjacent dwelling to aid privacy.</i>
