The aim of the 1st part of the project is to provide the boys & girls of Westbury Youth FC the opportunity to host a Tournament & Festival of Football at which up to 2000 other boys & girls from clubs from within & outside the county. The 300+ registered players of Westbury Youth (boys & girls aged 5-18) would benefit directly, as well as all the players of other clubs, by allowing them all to come together in a friendly, inclusive, enjoyable environment, taking part in physical activity and encouraging a greater sense of community spirit through meeting a wider group of young people. The aim of the 2nd part of the project is to support the continued development of the U10s Girls Section for Season 2010/2011 as well as the creation of an U12's Girls team . This part of the grant would be used to purchase new equipment and team strips for the Girls Age Groups instead of "hand me downs". It is estimated that 20-25 girls aged 10-12 will directly benefit from this part of the project in the first year with the potential for many more to become involved in the coming years. The outcome will be to involve these young girls in sport/physical activity from an early age, encouraging them to learn about being part of a team as well as engendering a sense of community. Overall, the project aim is to support the young people of Westbury Youth FC to represent the town in a positive manner and for the new members of the Club to have the best possible start to their sporting lives.

Wiltshire Council will be unable to meet the ongoing costs of your project. Please describe, therefore, how you will ensure the financial sustainability of your project beyond the period of this grant (if successful)?

The Tournament is a one off cost for the Club but unfortunately Tournament costs have increased significantly and one of our major supporters is no longer able to provide financial support putting the event at risk. It is hoped that funding from the Area Board Community Grant Scheme will make up the shortfall this year, ensuring that the 2000 young people aged 5-18 who attend the Tournament are not denied the opportunity to be part of such an important event in Westbury. Future funding will be sought from other sources if the tournament is staged in 2011. The support for the Girls' Age Groups is a one off start up cost and this will allow the female members of the Westbury Youth to have the best equipment and experience possible. Playing strips will not have to be replaced until season 2013/14 and funding will be sought at this time from other sources.

The sense of identity that is engendered, not only for the Club, but to the wider Community is a vital part of the event. The 300+ registered players of Westbury Youth (boys and girls aged 5-18) would benefit directly, as well as all the players of other clubs, by allowing them all to come together in a friendly, inclusive and enjoyable environment, taking part in physical activity and encouraging a greater sense of community spirit through meeting a wider group of young people. The Tournament will have Age Groups from Under 7s to Under 16s (ages 5-16) and will take place at Matravers School, Westbury. In past years, Clubs have come from around the county as well as from London, Surrey, Hampshire, Gloucestershire and Bristol. The support of the Girls Section allows the new female members of the Community access to organised sport, ensuring that they can experience the benefits of physical activity from an early age in a safe, all female environment. The increased participation of girls in healthy activity will allow the Club to make a real difference to the well recognised issue of ensuring girls undertake regular, organised exercise.
